AN AFFORDABLE SERVICE

Grange Primary School's Out of School Hours Care Program (OSHC) was established to meet the ever-growing needs of the school and local communities for extended childcare out of normal school hours for primary school aged children.

PROGRAM

Grange Primary School Outside School Hours Care believes that the balance of leisure, life skills and education is essential to a good OSHC program.

Our service offers a range of structured and casual learning opportunities to suit all children's individual needs and interests.

Services provided by the program include:

- Before School Care,
- After School Care,
- Pupil Free/School Closure Days and
- Vacation Care.

A Vacation Care program is made available to parents/caregivers during Week 5 of each school term, which is based on the Centre's belief that it is important to create an environment which allows for challenging, fun, child-initiated activities.

A Flying Start to School New Foundation Children

From December each year, children enrolled at Grange Primary School will be able to participate in our December/January Vacation Care. Our program is designed to prepare your child for the transition to school.

This is a great way to get your child feeling confident to starting school.

EDUCATORS

The nurturing staff of Grange Primary Outside School Hours Care strive to provide quality care for each individual child. All staff have at least a first aid certificate and have undergone child protection training. Staff aim to be good role models for the children, demonstrating how to live a healthy and happy lifestyle.



CANCELLATION

Not cancelled or late cancelled bookings will be charged at full fee.

An extra \$5 non-cancellation fee will be charged for any:

- ASC bookings not cancelled before 6pm the night before the day of care.
- BSC booking not cancelled before 6pm the night before.
- Any VAC bookings after the closing date.
- Any changes made to VAC bookings after it has been processed

Vacation Care cancellations need to be made 5 OSHC working days in advance.

Pupil Free Day bookings need to be received 2 OSHC working days in advance.
