SunSmart hat for Spring and Summer holidays
Medical Management Plan & Medication if applicable —> see for details.

Label all items with child's name!
Please note for excursions, children must be on-site and signed in 30 minutes prior to the stated departure time. This enables us to
go through safety rules, the day's event and procedures, and ensure children have all that is required of them.
Every child that attends Vacation Care on an excursion day will be required to have one of our Grange OSHC Excursion shirts.

#### Personal belongings!

Please leave all toys and precious items at home (including mobile phones) as they may be lost, broken, or taken.

No responsibility will be accepted for children's property brought to the centre.

### Changes to your booking!

Families are required to give a full 5 OSHC working days' notice to receive a refund for a cancellation or to swap days.

Any bookings after the closing date will be considered late and will incur a \$5.00 late fee. Any changes made to bookings after it has been processed will incur a \$5 admin fee.

#### **OSHC Staff Car Park!**

We are kindly asking for your assistance to ensure that our staff car park (on the corner of Surrey Street and Jetty Street) is not used as a drop-off/pick up point when bringing or taking your children to and from our centre.

Medical Management Plan & Medication

All children diagnosed with medical conditions, including allergies, food/chemical intolerances, anaphylaxis, asthma, and epilepsy, must provide the following:

- □ A completed Medical Management Plan□ Medical Condition Risk Minimisation Plan
- □ Necessary medication with the pharmacy label.

Please note that providing these documents is a legal requirement under the Education & Care National Regulations and the Terms and Conditions for booking.

For the safety of the children, care may be refused on the day if the appropriate documentation or medication is not supplied.
